

Additional Historical Proof

Dr. Julian Boyd, Professor of History at Princeton University, and President of The American Philosophical Association in Philadelphia attempted for our 200th Anniversary in 1976 to locate the missing "Original Draft Declaration of Independence" using President Thomas Jefferson's letter of September 16, 1825 to guide him. Thus, he assembled all the known copies of the Draft of the Declaration of Independence, he was unable to discover the copy that told him about the "vehement philippic portion against Negro Slavery" that had been in President John Adams letter to his former Secretary of State, Timothy Pickering. Thus the original was not to be found, but it was true that it did exist on September 16, 1825. The Original Draft Declaration of Independence was not to be discovered for our 200th Anniversary.

My brother, the late Larry A. Becker discovered a Government Memo acknowledging that Jacob Becker lost the Original Declaration of Independence in his house fire in 1832, when the Anti-Masonic rioters had attempted to kill him, when Larry was reading "Secret Treaty Number One". Larry was further surprised to discover that my 201 file was also stored in this restricted National Archive Library, which was manned by fulltime Army personnel. He noticed that this 201 file was started the day I was born. Larry was surprised to find our sister, Judy also had a 201 file. Larry had been able to discover history of many of the valuable tasks that Jacob Becker had completed for our country during this period prior to August 15, 1971. The Threat on Jacob Becker's life had shifted priority for our country, to that of protecting the location of Jacob Becker as the Anti-Masonic rioters continued for eleven years to find him. This protection was based upon a Special Presidential order by President Andrew Jackson. There was nothing to alter the scope of this order, therefore it has remained as secret to this day.

In order to justify the destruction of the Masonic Order's influence with the Senate after the Election of 1832, which had returned President Andrew Jackson for a second term, Senator Henry Clay had requested a document that President Andrew Jackson refused to submit to him. (Senator Henry Clay had been speaker of the House, three times before becoming a Senator.) The official Senate History relates how it was known that President Andrew Jackson had read this document to his cabinet. This document was "Secret Treaty Number One", signed by all the Delegates of the Second Continental Congress and Jacob Becker for the Foreign Powers. It represented the existence of the Masonic Order as treaty between the United States of America and the Foreign Power which Senator Henry Clay had attempted to reveal to justify his actions during the 1832 Election, in 1833. President Andrew Jackson became our only President to have been "Censored" by the United States Senate for denying Senator Henry Clay this document.

The protection of Jacob Becker's lineage was a major concern. People who should have attempted to contact this lineage concerning land and a Trust Account that they should have inherited. Concerns for their safety initially protected them from this receipt. Jacob Becker had attempted to protect this Treaty at the time he arranged the US Constitution. Article VI was his attempt to protect them in 1786. Larry had memorized "Secret Treaty Number One" and he had shared it with myself and our father. Larry knew that this information should have been made public. In 1982, I convinced Larry to run for Congress. We did well against an incumbent achieving over 40 % of the vote for the 18th Congressional Seat in Pennsylvania. While there is no legal reason for Jacob Becker's file to stay sealed, there is no path to make it public.

Have discovered new information that relates to the motivation of Marquis de Lafayette and his rationale in putting together the Franco – American Treaty which paid the US \$6 ½ Million in Gold. The Marquis was returning from his trip to the US in 1824 when Charles X obtained wealth from Haiti. This Dominican Republic was the area where the Marquis de Lafayette had purchased a large sugar plantation and hired a manager to train the Slaves for a year so they could earn a decent living as Freemen, while he was involved in the American Revolution. The Slaves were then freed after a year's worth that year. The concept of helping to secure money for the purchase of Texas with a strip of land above the 30 degree parallel, so that it would be free of Slavery would find a place in the heart of the Marquis de Lafayette. The Marquis de Lafayette was responsible for the short revolution that removed Charles X. This treaty supported shipping salvage that had been an open US claim against France since 1800. It was signed by France on July 4, 1831 and sent to the US. The Journal of Congress reveals that these funds had not been fully paid out by 1885 after their receipt.
